Spiritual Practices Class Begins With Lectio Divina

Sunday, March 16 was our first class in a five week series entitled "Ancient Spiritual Practices Made Relevant for Today" which is being facilitated by Jone Friesen in the gym during the Sunday school hour. We practiced the ancient art of being present to God or Lectio Divina – praying the Scriptures.

The intent of this spiritual practice was on the soul waiting in silence before God. While most of our prayers consist of <u>talking</u> to God, this practice emphasized prayer primarily as <u>listening</u> to God. We found out that listening is a difficult skill and we need to quiet down our "brain chatter" and internal noise so we could listen to God in prayer or through Scripture reading. Lectio Divina is a different approach to God, not looking at the Bible as an object, something to analyze, pull apart, study, or research but as an encounter.

Next Sunday, March 23 we will again practice Lectio Divina. Hope you will join us as we experience and share together.

CROSSES OF LOVE: MAR. 30th-APR.6th

Crosses of Love are a Dutch tradition which was adopted by New Haven in 1984. These wooden crosses are made by Dick Garwood, then decorated by our New Haven family with ribbons, silk flowers, and a touch of sweets, raisins, a religious bookmark, and a history of the crosses.

In Holland, the crosses are decorated by family and friends in a park the Saturday before Palm Sunday, then they are delivered to hospitals, children's homes, and nursing homes. We here at New Haven have shared the crosses with many different ministries; to name a few—Restore Hope, Hospice, Ronald McDonald House, and Exodus House. This year we will share them with the Street School students and staff and Restore Hope for their Chapel services.

Although we previously had large and small crosses decorated, this year we will only do the smaller cross because its easier for the students to take home. We'll have a few crosses decorated to show you for examples. You can take part in this ministry through your Sunday School class, but we will have extra crosses available for adults who do not attend Sunday School, but want to participate. Supplies will be in all classrooms by March 30th and the crosses should be decorated by April 10th so they can be dedicated on Palm Sunday, April 13th.
