

PICTURED ABOVE IS THE DISCOVERY CLASS AND BELOW IS THE INTERLUDE CLASS.









My family and I have lived in the New Haven Methodist neighborhood for nearly 30 years. Your church is such a lovely building filled with really nice people, too. Although we are Roman Catholic, we love having NHMC as an anchor to the neighborhood. We especially look forward to the big garage sale held in the gym each year.

I must tell you a story. Two years ago we attended the sale and I bought a box of fabric. I didn't pay much attention to it until last fall. I decided it was time to get the fabric out, wash and iron it and find ways to put it to use. In the bottom of the box I spied a 1 gallon zip lock bag of little fabric squares, rectangles and long strips. It was all color coordinated and beautiful! Someone had cut this up to make a quilt, but never assembled it. I thought of my Mom who lives in OKC in a Methodist retirement center that has been wonderful to my parents over the years. I decided to make Mom a lap quilt with the pieces. I had only to buy cream colored fabric for the edges and backing and some quilt batting.

As you can see from the pictures it turned out pretty well. My Mom, who was a professional seamstress, loved the beautiful fabric. She told me it was very high quality and someone really knew how to blend colors. We especially like the green cross in the center.
