Happy New Year!



As we all say goodbye to 2020 and say hello to 2021, I would like to reflect on some of the accomplishments of 2020. First of all, even in the midst of the pandemic, New Haven UMC not only survived, but thrived in so many ways. We made a quick pivot back in March to online worship. This allowed us to continue worshipping as a community even when it wasn't possible for us to be together in person. Volunteers quickly stepped up to call and check in on our members to make sure everyone was doing ok in the midst of lockdown. Even though 10 months later, we are still under covid restrictions, we have much to be thankful for. We have two Sunday School and one Tuesday evening connection groups that are meeting by Zoom (see information on Page 2.) We have also added another

connection group called Coffee With the Pastor on Tuesday mornings where members gather informally on Zoom, drink their beverage of choice, (mine is coffee hence the name) pray together, and spend time either visiting, sharing a devotion, or discussing books we are reading. The children are still being supported with a Facebook group called Children's Church at Home where parents can go to get lessons, art projects, and inspiration for teaching their own children about Jesus. We conducted a Virtual Vacation Bible School this Summer, and we have continued to feed the hungry through Restore Hope Ministries and Day Center for the Homeless. We provided gifts for more than 60 children with our Angel Tree offerings, and through the generosity of our members, we have aided several families with food and emergency shelter through contributions to the Pastor's Alms Fund.

While 2020 may have disrupted our lives, it did not keep us from responding to God's call to be a community of heart and soul helping to make disciples for Jesus Christ by being God's love in action! My heart goes out to each of you, and I ask you to stay strong in 2021, stay positive, and test negative!


