Dear friends,

As we walk the Lenten journey with Christ, I am reflecting on the year that we have all traveled together and yet separately. Covid-19 has changed our lives in so many ways. It has changed the way we worship. It has changed the way we participate in learning. It has deeply changed the way we have experienced community, and yet it has not changed one thing. We are all deeply loved by God, and even in the midst of change, suffering, and death, we can count on the promise of the resurrection.

March 28<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. we will start holy week with our Palm Sunday service. We will reflect on the experience of Christ as he journey's towards the cross. On Maundy Thursday, at 7 p.m. April 1<sup>st</sup>, we will celebrate the sacrament of holy communion and remember Jesus' last supper with His disciples. On Friday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> again at 7 p.m., we will re-imagine the Good Friday experience and the crucifixion, Then, finally, on Easter Sunday, April 4<sup>th</sup>, at 11:00 a.m. we will gather in the sanctuary and online to proclaim the victory over death and announce the resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ!

If you have had both of your vaccinations and are at least two weeks out from your last vaccination, I want to encourage you to join us in person on Easter morning! We are still observing social distancing, and masks are still required, but I am hoping that we can declare our hope for the future and worship together! I know that some of you will still be needing to remain at home and worship with us by livestream, and if you do not feel safe being here in person, I want to encourage you to do so. For those who can, we will join our voices in proclaiming the risen Christ and bring hope to all who are watching! With God's help, we will endure and prosper!


