These camps will be for three-days a week from 9 am to 2 pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. In the fall, we will add an after-school program for the Carnegie Elementary School children from 2:30 pm to 5:30 pm for five-days a week and provide a two-days a week option along with the three-days a week option for the pre-school program. We have made the decision to go with a program where church members and volunteers can live out the vision of being a "Community of Heart & Soul" by volunteering to help in the classrooms. Currently rooms are being prepared for painting; closets are being cleaned out; lights and ceiling tiles are being replaced. We want to present a sparkling, orderly, secure area when parents/guardians come to tour our facilities. Tours will be starting sometime in February – more to come.
