Just what is "Safe Sanctuaries" exactly? Have you heard people talk

about this, but weren't quite sure what it means? If so, I'm glad you asked! First, let me say that it is not a signal that our beautiful Sanctuary is safely secured and locked.... It is so much more important than that!

The 1996 General Conference of the United Methodist Church adopted an important resolution aimed at reducing the risk of abuse against children, youth and vulnerable adults in the church. From 1996 forward, the Oklahoma Annual Conference has encouraged local churches to adopt these guidelines for their own safety policy and procedures.

This important covenant includes 11 guidelines for the local church; the first four of these include:

youth and vulnerable adults. We have adopted this policy in covenant with all United Methodist Congregations in the Oklahoma Conference.

"Safe Sanctuaries" - What Does it Mean?

- Providing supervision and support for workers with children, youth and vulnerable adults.
- Educating all workers regarding the use of all appropriate polices and procedures.

And, this is where YOU come in. New Haven UMC has adopted a "Safe Sanctuary" Policy that requires training for anyone who works or volunteers with children, youth or vulnerable adults.

Our congregation's purpose for establishing this policy is to demonstrate our absolute and unwavering commitment to the safety of all of our children, For those who work or volunteer with these named groups, the next training date will take place on Sunday, May 17th at 12:15 pm in the parlor. If you have not previously attended training this year, and you work or volunteer with children, youth or vulnerable adults, please let Allyson Cauthon know so that we can register you for the May 17th session.

"Safe Sanctuaries" is a visible part of proclaiming who we are as Christians; those who care for and value the safety of all.
