Good morning my friends!

We had a wonderful service yesterday! The Holy Spirit was present, and our people were moved to serve as we participated in an in-service opportunity following both services!

We welcomed a new young member named Emmalena through profession of faith and baptism. We are excited to have her! Emmalena first visited us during Vacation Bible School this past summer, and through the love and nurturing of our church family, she

has come to accept Christ as her personal lord and savior! It doesn't get more exciting than that!

Our parlor work is progressing well. We're expecting to get started painting today or tomorrow, and plan to make the flooring selections this Wednesday. It will be nice when it is finished!

I would also like to fill all of you in on the bus stop issue. As you will recall, we had some problems last spring with unruly children and damage being done to our property. In response to that, we suspended the volunteer led program to provide breakfast to the students. This summer we asked for volunteers to monitor the parking lot and did not receive a sufficient number of volunteers to ensure the safety of the children. After discussion and prayer, the trustees felt that unless something else could be done to protect the children and staff, that it might be necessary to request the bus stop be moved. Our trustee chair attempted to call and email the school system multiple times prior to August 1st. We received no response either by phone or email. School started and the buses were still here, so we assumed that we were going to continue to be a bus stop. Then, suddenly, when I was gone on vacation, the school unilaterally changed the bus stop locations with very little notice to the students and parents and with no notice to us. Understandably, parents were upset. Many of them blamed us for the inconvenience and the sudden change. In response to all of this. I have reached out to the schools and we are attempting to restore bus service with some better guidelines and supervision of the students. One bus is already being serviced here. Please pray that we can get things worked out for the benefit of the church, the students, and the community. Grace and peace,
