God is certainly at work in and through New Haven Church! I want to share the GOOD NEWS with you about our efforts for raising funds for a new minibus.

Can I just say, our Day School is awesome?! Of course, you already know that! Here's another reason to give thanks. The New Haven Day School Council has just voted to approve funds for a matching gift toward the purchase of a minibus. Beginning Sunday, July 20th, ANY gift made to the Mini-Bus fund will be matched by the Day School—up to \$20,000!!

Yes, that's what I said! \$20,000!! That means, if you make a gift of \$500, it magical-

ly turns into \$1,000! If you make a gift of \$1,000, it doubles to \$2,000. You get the point. This matching happens all the way up to a total of \$20,000 until August 31st!!!

As of this writing, we have over \$17,000 already collected in the Mini-Bus fund. If we collect another \$20,000 (which will be

Listening Posts Offered—Topic: Oklahoma Conference Re-Districting

The Annual Conference voted to reduce the number of districts in the Oklahoma Annual Conference from 12 to 8 as of June 1, 2015. This will cause the creation of new districts with new names and boundaries. Later this summer, the Cabinet will officially set the new boundaries.

Currently, the District offices are forming teams to lead us

through this time of transition.

The proposal spoke of Listening Post meetings in each District for the sharing of information about the realignment, and hearing feedback from the laity and clergy of the Annual Conference.




