Pastor Cindy's Sermon last week "Invite, Invite, Invite" encouraged each of us to be aware of those we might know who do not attend a church and help them to find their way to New Haven. We do have a responsibility as United Methodists " to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world". Many of you may know Rev. Bob Pierson who for many years was pastor at Christ United Methodist at 36<sup>th</sup> and Harvard. He now leads many workshop and seminars on Effective Evangelism all over this country and he recently was invited to England for the Anglican Church's Lenten Series. He was excited about learning more about the British church to become aware of their commitment, their interest and concern about spreading the gospel.

However what he found in England caused him to have great concern for the Church worldwide. While the church in the U.S. is on a great decline it is on an even greater decline in the U.K. Church leaders are closing churches continuously due to inadequate finances and lack of attendance. He said they saw beautiful church buildings used for meeting halls, one was a cafe and retail store. There were beautiful old cathedrals, now empty of any church relationships, serving meals and merchandise, rather than Jesus. At one place he saw an old steeple being used as a decoration in a rock garden made from stones of old church buildings.

One of the facts we learned from Rev. Rodney Newman Chaplain at our own Oklahoma City University is that many young people today do not claim a church and they will put NONE on the church affiliation line in any application. Many of them are very spiritual but do not want to be associated with any particular denomination. So what does that mean for us?

"There's great expectation when we Christians are put to work; our work of inviting people to God, our work of changing people's lives, our work of making Disciples. We hold our Mission Statement to be a core value in our lives. Not just in our lives, but in the life of New Haven church. Do you remember what that Mission Statement is? To make a difference in the world for Christ. To be love in action. And we do that by inviting others to church, and showing them that there is a place for you here."

Invite others to walk the journey of faith with you and with us to change the world... to save the world... to make a difference in another's life for Christ.
