Attending Annual Conference is a highlight every year. If you want to find out what the United Methodist Church is all about, this is the place!

This year, among other important proposals to be discussed and voted on, there is one proposal I think you will be especially interested in. Several of us attended a Pre-Conference meeting yesterday that discussed a significant change; a proposal for the missional realignment of the Districts. What does that mean to us as New Haven Church?

The proposal that will be up for conference vote is to decrease our current 12 districts to 8 districts by or on June 1, 2015. The intention is to locate approximately 55-65 churches in each of four urban districts. Each of the four more rural districts will have about 65-75 churches.

The district superintendent will work in the newly formed district to appoint a District Transition Team that will include the persons required by *The Book of Discipline*

(District Trustees, Lay Leader, Committee on Ministry, Director of Lay Servant Ministries, Property, etc.)

This team will be comprised of an equal number of laity and clergy, and will also be comprised of the district's most spiritually mature and visionary lay and clergy leaders, to assist the superintendent in major strategic decisions. Over the last two years in consultation with Dr. Lovett Weems—and after much prayer, analysis and discussion—several major issues have been identified that directly impact maximizing the effective ministry of the Oklahoma Conference. The issues that the conference will be voting on are the results of the 'best work' by many people.

Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church: May 26th-29th

The Annual Conference Corporation is the only group having a representative from all entities of the Annual Conference sitting at God's table.

This proposal came from asking the question, "Is the Oklahoma Annual Conference as effective in ministry as possible and are apportionment dollars being utilized as effective as possible to fulfill God's missions as affirmed previously in our Strategic Plan?"

Several District meetings and round table discussions have given many the opportunity to learn more about these issues.

Please give prayerful consideration to all those who are voting on Thursday of Annual Conference. Our hearts desire is to help the Oklahoma Annual Conference be at its best in ministry and mission for our Lord, Jesus Christ.


