A big thanks to New Haven UMC for your support of the The Happy Children's Home of China! We filled three tables of New Haven members at the Oct. 24th benefit "It's All About the Children!" Thanks to so many of you who came to the dinner and entertainment and fine arts! Thanks especially to the two New Haven members who were featured on the program, Pamela Prescott and Gracelyn Logsdon. The New Haven youth served the meal like pros, along with Circle of Care youth and the Chinese Christian Church. A New Haven member was highest bidder on the silent auction painting of the home by Adriaan Duiveman's uncle in Maine! All in all, over \$11,000 was raised at the event!
