from God? Scripture offers an answer to the question.... and the answer is....not very likely.

It's easy to check this on your own. Pick any biblical figure and count the number of times God instructed them personally, and then compare that to how long the person lived.

Our call is simple: Use well the abilities that God has given you. The truth is, we won't always know what to do; sometimes we'll miss the mark. But the goal isn't to avoid painful
