Dihydrogen monoxide (DHMO, otherwise known as H₂O, water!),

has not been kind to the church as experienced by the past several years of symptoms (floor moisture, roof & water line leaks) from 40-50 years since the East wing and Sanctuary were built. The good news is that progress has been made on one of the three water issues and the Trustees are in the process of planning/repair on the others.

Water 2" Line that feeds the center section and Sanctuary was replaced and other dripping facets/toilets have been repaired. The last two months of water billings indicate usage returned to normal.

Steeple and Balcony Roof Leaks – the first of 3 phases have been completed:

Phase 1 completed - create safe access into the steeple, add in attic lighting for access, add power circuits for phase 2 & 3 work, wasp control in steeple.

Phase 2 will address major repairs to steeple drain tray, brick veneer flashing (top and transition to roof deck. Trustees are in planning discussions with the main contractor. Once these repairs are completed, then the visible balcony ceiling tile/insulation repairs will be made. Depending upon the weather and resource

Repairs on these Dihydrogen monoxide issues probably are not progreting as fast as some hope; these are taking longer than hoped, but the Trustees are performing the necessary investigation to determine the problem, identify potential longer term solutions (versus Band-Aids), then contracting with qualified profes-

availability, completion is hoped to done before the end of the 1st quarter 2016. Sooner is always hoped for.

Phase 3 will be more extensiverepair the water leaks coming into the steeple from upwards from the lower brick veneer section.

East Wing Water Runoff and Ground Water moved away from footings/floor/wall to address a couple of floor and wall moisture damaged areas. This repair work necessary for 1st floor re-flooring. sionals, and getting it done. This takes time.

Your patience is greatly appreciated as the Trustees work through the multiple work efforts.
