

In his new and widely acclaimed book, Max Lucado talks about the power of a simple prayer, and helps us look at our own prayer life. We want to pray... but when? We want to pray... but why?

Lucado shares with us the idea of using a simple prayer. It's really more like a simple tool for prayer. Now, if you get prayer, you probably don't need this... but if you struggle with prayer... this is something that might help.

This past Sunday we've given out small laminated cards with this simple prayer on it: "God, you are good. I need help. They need help. Thank you. In Jesus' name, Amen."


ALLYSON'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

We have two Mission groups here at New Haven that work with children.

- 1) **Bus Stop Ministry**: Children from elementary age to high school come to the church on school day mornings to enjoy a snack, play games, do homework, visit, and get out of the weather. The first group arrives around 6:50 a.m. and the last group leaves before 8:00 a.m. The school buses come to the parking lot and load up the kids. The church gymnasium provides a safe place for these children waiting for the school bus. Volunteers are needed to help with the students (from 45 50) each day. - 2) **Respite Care**: Monthly, normally the second Saturday from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m., children with special needs and their siblings come to the church to enjoy snacks, crafts, music, group games, free play, and supper. This gives the parents a reprieve from caregiving, as well as a time to run errands. You can come play for an hour or four!
