I recently came across an article in "Children's Ministry Magazine" about apps that are great for kids. I've looked at all of these and plan to download them onto a tablet for our house. Most of them are free, which is great! For more information, you can use the provided links.

Bible App for Kids (<u>https://www.bible.com/kids</u>) – This is the kid version of the incredibly popular YouVersion app. It's just as useful–and just as free–as the grown-up version.

Buddy Quest (<u>http://buddyquest.com/</u>) – It help kids "learn and practice biblical virtues in the real world." There's a free parent app that helps parents and kids connect on the things kids are learning. Sign up for an email to alert you when it's available.

ChoreMonster (<u>https://www.choremonster.com/</u>) – This helps parents and kids track chores. Each chore is worth a certain number of points, and kids can turn in points to buy items such as money, TV time, a video game, and other things.

Hunger Crunch (<u>http://www.hungercrunch.com/</u>) – It has in-app purchases, but every penny goes toward feeding hungry kids. The app just won Facebook's Social App of the Year award.

Parent Cue (<u>http://theparentcue.org/app/</u>) – Costs \$1.99, and comes with constantly updated content that lets kids and parents connect about spiritual matters. There are videos, activities, and questions, divided into sections, such as Drive Time, Meal Time, and Parent Time.

YouTube Kids (Downloadable from iTunes or Google Play) – A free app that lets kids safely search for video appropriate for them. You can't upload, share, or comment on this version of YouTube. And the search function is beefed -up and ready to block anything inappropriate. Kids love videos, and this is a safe way for kids to watch them.
