

The *UMPTEENAGERS* will be visiting the Sherwin Miller Museum of Jewish Art, 2021 E. 71st Street on Tuesday, February 19th . "The purpose of the museum is to preserve and promote Jewish heritage, culture, history and community through art and education." The entryway is eye catching with its tall stained-glass windows depicting biblical scenes. The lower level has a permanent Holocaust exhibit with

hundreds of documents and photos of this ghastly time in history. "The permanent exhibit on the upper level displays art and artifacts from the 5,000 year history of the Jewish people, beginning in the pre-Canaanite era in the Middle East down to the settling of the Jewish communities in Oklahoma and Tulsa." A visit to this accredited museum will be well worth your time.


Our resident does not have a car and would like volunteers to pick
