Happy Easter!

On **Sunday, April 17th** we will gather in the sanctuary of New Haven United Methodist Church, whether in person or by www.livestream.com/newhaventulsa and we will celebrate God's victory over sin and death! The past several weeks, I have been working with Rev. Gloria Denton and 4 amazing young people as we have examined our faith in preparation for Confirmation this Easter!

Article II of our Doctrinal Standards states "The Son, who is the Word of the Father, the very and eternal God, of one substance with the Father, took man's nature in the womb of the blessed Virgin; so that two whole and perfect natures, that is to say, the Godhead and Manhood, were joined together in one person, never to be divided; whereof is one Christ very God and very Man, who truly suffered, was crucified, dead, and buried, to reconcile his Father to us, and to be a sacrifice, not only for original guilt, but also for actual sins of men." In other words, Jesus was Fully Human and Fully Divine! 100% Human and 100% Divine! One of our students said, "That's impossible! One can't be 100% of two different things, that doesn't add up!" She had a point, mathematically, it doesn't work! But the wonderful thing about God is that God isn't bound by mathematical principals! God is so much more powerful and creative than we are! Personally, I am greatly comforted by the idea that our God loved us enough to become vulnerable and come and dwell among us in human form. Our God knows our human emotions, understands our fears, and can empathize with the struggle and pain that we endure. Our God knows all of these things and through grace gives us the opportunity to overcome! Through the resurrection, we bear witness that the limits of this world cannot constrain our divine possibilities. Nothing, not even death, can separate us from the love of God!



NEEDED: Sewing Machines and Sewing Supplies (not fabric)

We have an opportunity to help our new neighbors; those who have recently arrived from Afghanistan. There have been multiple requests for sewing machines—therefore, we are organizing a collection and distribution process.

We know that there are individuals with working portable sewing machines that have not been used for a while and are likely not to be used in the future. If you have one (or two +) of these, this is your opportunity to rehome them. Our new Afghan neighbors arrived with very little. Catholic Charities, other organizations and lots of generous individuals have done a great job of organizing the original settlement into Tulsa with housing, food, medical treatment, and lots of compassion and support.

As they have settled in, other needs have become apparent—functioning sewing machines and supplies are a great need right now. Therefore, we are asking, if you have a portable sewing machine that you are not using (it is in a closet or attic), that you pull it out (and the instruction manual, if you have it), check to be sure you have the power pedal, bobbins. In addition, we are taking donations of related supplies such as quality sewing scissors, pinking shears, straight pins, sewing needles, and pin cushions.

If you have a machine or two and/or some related supplies that you want to donate, **please bring** them to St. Paul's United Methodist Church at 15th (Cherry Street) and Quaker during one of the following times:

Tuesday—April 12, 19 and 26 4p.m. to 6 p.m.

Saturday—April 16, 23 and 30 10 a.m. to noon.
